


#### The Ichiro Era

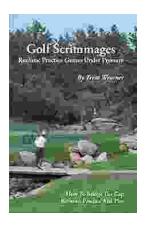
